1. MEMBER'S RESPONSIBILITY

The enjoyment of golf depends a great deal on the co-operation, consideration and courtesy exhibited by fellow competitors. This courtesy and consideration should extend to the choice of dress and generally in the standard of conduct on the course and in the Clubhouse. The standards of a Golf Club may be judged by the etiquette of its members.

2. CONDITION OF COMPETITION PLAY

It is the player's responsibility to remove their name from the time sheet immediately they become aware of their inability to meet their tee time. This can be done by either withdrawing your name from the online booking sheet prior to the day of play, or calling the Pro Shop 07 32793073 on or before the day of play. A player will be subjected to disciplinary action by the committee for failing to meet their obligations in complying with this rule. The disciplinary action may involve warnings and or suspension and the competition fee being paid.

Players are also reminded that they should turn up 15 minutes prior to their appointed tee time and register with the Pro Shop. Should they fail to do this they may also be subjected to the aforementioned disciplinary actions. Each player must have their own set of clubs and the set must consist of at least three clubs and a putter

All competition cards are to be returned to the designated area within 10 minutes of the round being competed and your score is to be recorded on the touch screen provided where applicable.

It is the player's responsibility to ensure their name, membership (Golflink number for visitors) and handicap are shown on their score card.

3. DRESS STANDARD

All players are required to ensure that they are aware of the following minimum dress requirements for our course:

- Neat and tidy shorts, slacks, dresses or skirts.
- Shirts and blouses with collars or collarless golf shirts and turtle-neck shirts are preferred.
- Shoes must be fully enclosed and metal spikes or boots are not permitted.
- The following is not permitted:
 - shirts with bawdy or offensive wording or images
 - singlets
 - torn or dirty clothing is not permitted.

Please note:

Hats, including caps and visors are NOT to be worn in the club house. This is a long-standing golf tradition, please respect it.

4. POINTS TO REMEMBER

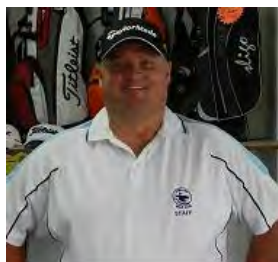
- Ensure all Members enjoy their game by observing the Etiquette of Golf.
- Know, understand and enforce the 'Rules of Golf'.
- Check the Local Rules and the Conditions of Play displayed outside the Pro Shop.
- Check your allotted time and be ready to play at least 15 minutes before your starting time.
- Please return your cart as soon as you are able to after your round.
- Enter your score into the touch screen where applicable and ensure that your scorecards are signed and handed back in the Pro Shop within 10 minutes of finishing play.
- It is the responsibility of each group to keep up with the group in front of them; preventing slow play is everyone's responsibility.
- Do not hit up on players in front of you.
- Carry a sand bucket, repair your divots and pitch marks.

6. COMPETITION CHANGES

- In the event of fewer than 15 competitors contesting an event, the trophy will be postponed and a sweepstakes is substituted.
- Thursday Ladies: if fewer than 8 competitors contesting an event, the trophy will be postponed and a sweepstakes is substituted.
- If an event has started and 50% or more of the players that book in to play (at the commencement of play) complete the event, the event will be declared valid.
- If less than this then the sponsor of the day can decide to award the trophy; otherwise a sweepstakes is substituted.
- In December and January – the last tee off time for a Saturday competition will be 12pm.

7. COMPETITION HANDICAPS

- All events except foursomes are played off full handicaps.
- Foursomes events are played off half of the combined handicaps.
- Match play handicaps – Daily Handicaps
- Ambrose events are played off either $\frac{1}{8}$ of the sum of the team handicaps for a 4 person team, $\frac{1}{4}$ for a 2 person team and $\frac{1}{6}$ for a 3 person team.

8. EAGLE EYE 14 Jackpot hole

One ball will be available each week, jack potting until the prize is claimed. The distance from the cup/hole will be 10cm in week1, incrementing by 10cm each week until the prize is claimed. For example, week 3 will be 6 balls available for players whose ball is within 30cm. The Pro Shop can advise the target distance at any time, if more than 1 player is within the target range the ball pool will be split.

9. BIRDS NEST

The bird's nest for 2024 will be on the **1st, 10th and 15th hole**. One ball will be available each week, jackpotting until the prize is claimed. The player needs to have a birdie on one of these holes and CIRCLE this on your score card to claim the prize. If a player does not circle this score – the prize will not be available.

10. NTP

The nearest to the pin will be on the **4th/13th, 5th/14th and 8th/17th**. The nearest to the pin on these holes will receive 5 golf balls.

11. EAGLES NEST

The Eagles Nest is for a player who has an eagle on any hole (besides 7th and 16th) or a hole in one. This increases by 1 golf ball each week until the prize is won.

12. COUNT BACKS

- All non-honour board events will be by way of count back.
- A count back will be performed as follows:
- For 18 hole events the best score for the last 9 holes shall be used, if there is still a tie the last 6 holes or if still tied the last 3 holes. If a tie still persists then hole by hole from the 18th.

2024 will see the introduction of stableford competition for those members who are in C Grade. The C Grade champion will be the winner with the most points after 4 rounds.

The Nett winners will be determined after 4 rounds (A, and B Grade, Seniors, Masters and Ladies, Juniors (if applicable)). Starting Handicaps will be maintained throughout the competition.

The overall winners of 4 rounds will determine the overall Club Champion for each grade.

There will be no club matchplay this year as the club championships will be played over 4 rounds of stroke play

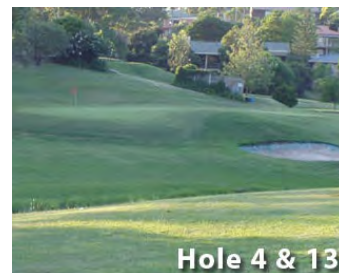
Hole 2 has a slight dogleg right and **hole 11** is straight with water on the right-hand side of the fairway. The fairway is generously wide, and a good drive will only leave you with a short to mid iron into a green 17 metres wide and 13 metres deep. This hole does have bunkers on the right and left side of the green. A bank at the rear of the green encourages approach shots to be longer rather than shorter.



Hole 3 and 12 is a dog leg left from an elevated tee with a water hazard approximately 120 metres from the tee across the fairway and then circumnavigating the bottom and right-hand side of the fairway together with a row of trees on the left-hand side of the fairway complicated by out of bounds from the water hazard to approximately 35 metres from the left-hand side of the green, makes cutting the corner a risky option. and provides a challenge from the tee.

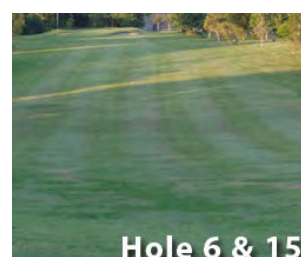

Hole 6 and 15 are probably one of the hardest holes on the course, with out of bounds along the entire right-hand side of the fairway and trees on the left. The fairway is fairly wide, but a good tee shot is required to allow a clear approach shot into an odd shaped green 25 metres long and 5 metres wide at the narrowest and 12 metres wide at the widest points, sloping from back to front. There is a green side bunker in the front right and a hazard over the back of the green.



Hole 7 and 16 is a straight short par 4 that causes problems for golfers that “go for it” and don’t hit it straight. The green is 22 metres long and 11 metres wide protected by green side bunkers in the front right and middle right, A fairway bunker 22 metres in the front of the green will catch anything short. Trees on the left and right also will cause problems for wayward shots. With any approach shot having to come into the green from the left, likely to finish up in the right-hand



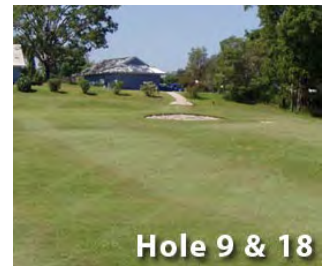

Hole 8 and 17 is a simple short par 3 to a large green 21 metres deep and 11 metres wide with bunkers in the front left and middle left. A water hazard across the fairway 65 metres short of the green does not really come into play here. However, a long shot can be risky with out of bounds some 10 metres through the back of the green. A generously wide fairway with out of bounds on the far right.
